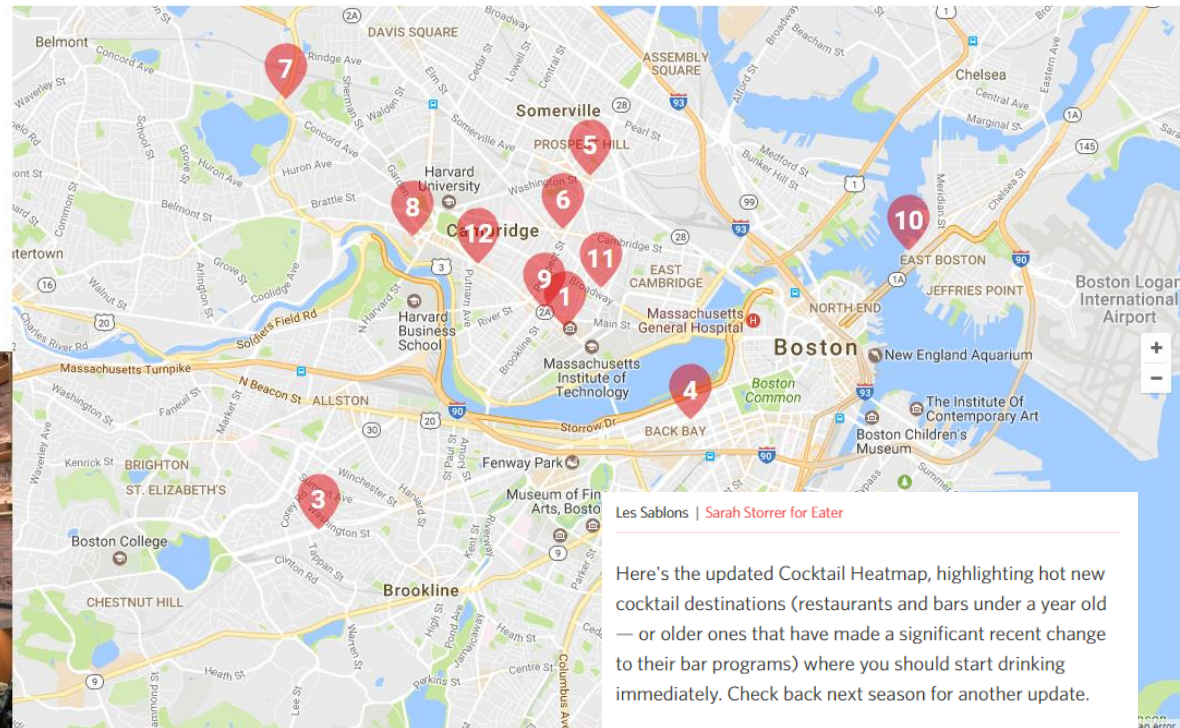


The Cocktail Heatmap: Where to Drink Right Now

Here's the updated Cocktail Heatmap, highlighting hot new cocktail destinations (restaurants and bars under a year old — or older ones that have made a significant recent change to their bar programs) where you should start drinking immediately. Check back next season for another update.

The Cocktail Heatmap is full of new additions this time around: **A4cade** in Cambridge's Central Square, **Bully Boy Distillers** in Roxbury, **Burro Bar** in Brookline's Washington Square, **Buttermilk & Bourbon** in Back Bay, **Casa B** in Somerville's Union Square, **Freepoint Kitchen & Cocktails** in Cambridge's Fresh Pond, **Les Sablons** in Cambridge's Harvard Square, and **Reelhouse** in East Boston.

Please note that the map points are listed in alphabetical order; they are not ranked.
